BTES RECEIVES NATIONAL RECOGNITION

BTES earned a Reliable Public Power Provider (RP3) Diamond Level designation from the American Public Power Association (APPA) for providing reliable and safe electric service and also achieved first place in Group E of the APPA Safety Awards of Excellence!

RP3

The RP3 designation, which lasts for three years, recognizes public power utilities that demonstrate proficiency in four key disciplines: reliability, safety, workforce development, and system improvement. Criteria include sound business practices and a commitment to safe and reliable delivery of electricity.


"I think over the last year or so, we've seen the vital importance of running a reliable and safe utility," says Aaron Haderle, Chair of APPA's RP3 Review Panel and Manager of Transmission and Distribution Operations at Kissimmee Utility Authority, Florida. "The utilities receiving the RP3 designation have proven that they are committed to running a top-notch public power utility by implementing industry best practices."

Of the 2,000 public power utilities nationwide, only 276 have achieved the RP3 designation. BTES has held the diamond level (the top level) since 2015.

"We are proud to be honored with this designation," said Mike Browder, CEO of BTES. "This is the culmination of a lot of work from a lot of people who really care about powering our community. We are committed to continuing to look for ways to improve our operations and service to our customers.

SAFETY AWARD

Of the 2,000 public power utilities across the country, 318 utilities entered the annual Safety Awards.

"BTES values safety above all else," said Browder. "We all recognize the importance of going home to our families each day; this is what drives our dedication to safety."

Entrants were placed in categories according to their number of worker-hours and ranked based on the most incident-free records during 2021.

"In our industry, safety is the top priority," said Bob Scudder, Chair of APPA's Safety Committee and Industrial Hygiene and Corporate Risk Manager at Grand River Dam Authority. "This is a commitment that needs to permeate every aspect of operations. These

awarded utilities have embraced this priority, and they deserve to be celebrated."

The Safety Awards have been held annually for more than 65 years.

I knew that he was even more afraid of poisonous snakes than me...and that's pretty bad. That was my last day in the minnow business.

WHAT IS STREAMING?

As Smart TVs and streaming services such as Netflix have exploded in popularity, more and more content is available outside of the traditional cable service. All you need is an Internet connection and a streaming device to get the Live TV channels you love, reruns On-Demand, and even brand-new content from streaming service providers! Some streaming providers or using a digital antenna can be used to pick up broadcast networks such as ABC, CBS, NBC, and FOX.

WHAT'S A SMART TV OR DEVICE? DO I HAVE ONE?

Newer TVs most likely have the ability to stream many of the services available. If you are interested in having access to a broader set of streaming services, or have an older TV, then Roku, Amazon, Google and others all sell affordable Streaming Devices that turn almost any TV into a Smart TV. Streaming Devices offer an easy and simple-to-use interface that allows you to watch your favorite shows and movies. You can connect your TV or streaming device to your BTES Wi-Fi network. Once connected, you're ready to stream!

WHY IS STREAMING A GOOD OPTION?

We want our customers to have and pay for the channels they want and watch the most - and streaming services using a BTES Internet connection is a great option. Ninety percent of traditional cable networks are owned or controlled by just eight multi-billion-dollar corporations – which includes those channels you want, as well as many channels you don't. The networks won't let us provide you with just the most-popular channels unless we take their less-popular ones, too - and pay a high price. As they continue to use their size and power to demand more money, we work hard to keep costs under control - and this is becoming harder and harder. Just one example is the Local Broadcast Retransmission Fee which is the fee we are charged by the local broadcast network affiliates of ABC, CBS, CW, FOX, and NBC in exchange for consent to rebroadcast the same channels and programming that are available for free with an antenna. When BTES started providing cable service in 2005, the retransmission fees charged by local broadcasters amounted to .75 cents per customer per month. These fees have continued to rise and drastically increase. The entire amount collected for Local Retransmission Fees (as shown on your bill) is remitted directly to the local broadcast networks.


"Our employees work hard every day to exceed our customers' expectations in the services we provide, and we feel this award is a reflection of that," said BTES CEO Mike Browder.

BTES RECEIVES NATIONAL RECOGNITION FOR TREE PROGRAM


The Arbor Day Foundation named Bristol Tennessee Essential Services a Tree Line USA recipient for the 22nd time in honor of its commitment to proper tree pruning, planting and care in its service area.

Tree Line USA, a partnership between the Foundation and the National Association of State Foresters, recognizes public and private utilities for pursuing practices that protect and enhance America's urban trees. Tree Line USA promotes the dual goals of delivering safe and reliable electricity while maintaining healthy community forests.

"Trees are a critical part of urban landscapes all across the United States," said Dan Lambe, president of the Arbor Day Foundation. "They provide important benefits to residents, including clean air, clean water and a tolerable climate. Service providers like Bristol Tennessee Essential Services demonstrate that it's possible for trees and utilities to co-exist for the benefit of communities and citizens."

BTES achieved Tree Line USA by meeting five program standards. Utilities must follow industry standards for quality tree care, provide annual worker training in best tree care practices, sponsor a tree planting and public education program, maintain a tree-based energy conservation program, and participate in an Arbor Day celebration.

Small Tree Zone

Trees with a mature height of less than 25' should be planted at least 20' from lines.

ex: Dogwood, Japanese Red Maple

Medium Tree Zone

Trees with a mature height of 25' - 40' should be planted at least 40' from lines.

ex: Bradford Pear, Crape Myrtle

Large Tree Zone

Trees with a mature height of 40' or more should be planted at least 60' from lines.

ex: Pine, Oak, Hemlock, Leyland Cypress

Favolite Recipes

Crockpot Taco Chicken

3-4 boneless, skinless chicken breasts

1/2 cup water
